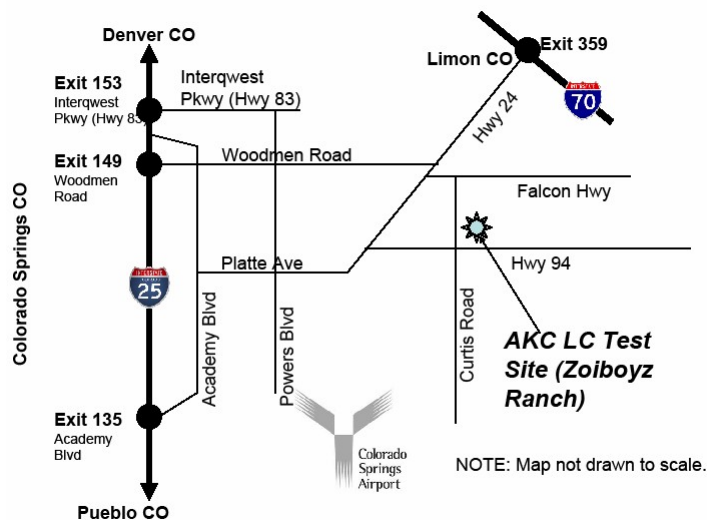

**FROM THE SOUTH**

1. From I-25 North, take exit 135 Academy Blvd
2. North on Academy 5.8 miles to East Platte Ave
3. Right on E. Platte 3.7 miles to Hwy 94 (direction Shriever AFB)
4. Right on Hwy 94 7.5 miles to Curtis Road (2nd light on Hwy 94)
5. Left on Curtis Road 1.9 miles to mailbox 2115 and Zoiboyz Ranch on right—it is the house surrounded by white fence on the hill. (Ignore the small house in front near Curtis Road. You've gone too far north on Curtis if you come to Falcon Hwy and a blinking red traffic signal.)

**FROM THE NORTH**

1. From I-25 South, take exit 153 Interquest Parkway/Hwy 83
2. Go on Hwy 83 to South Powers Blvd
3. Turn right on South Powers Blvd
4. Stay on Powers to Woodmen Road Exit
5. Go left (east) ~12 miles on Woodmen to its end at Hwy 24
6. Go right on Hwy 24 0.5 miles to Meridian
7. Go left on Meridian to STOP sign at Falcon Hwy
8. Turn left onto Falcon Hwy ~3 miles to flashing yellow (Curtis Rd)
9. Turn right (south) onto Curtis Road for 4.4 miles to mailbox 2115.
10. Turn left to Zoiboyz Ranch (NOTE: This will be the 2nd driveway on left after Davis Road. Ignore small house near Curtis Road; go on up the hill to the house surrounded by white fence. You've gone too far down Curtis if you come to Hwy 94 and a traffic signal)

**FROM THE EAST**

1. From I-70, take exit 359 (US Hwy 24) 54 miles to Falcon Hwy
2. Left (east) on Falcon Hwy 3.3 miles to Curtis Road
3. Right (south) on Curtis Road 4.4 miles to mailbox 2115.
4. Turn left to Zoiboyz Ranch (NOTE: This will be the 2nd driveway on left after Davis Road. Ignore small house near Curtis Road; go up the hill to the house surrounded by white fence. You've gone too far south on Curtis Road if you come to Hwy 94 and a traffic signal).

### Eligible Breeds & Registry:

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.)

**ROLL CALL:** PROMPTLY AT 8:15A.M.

Any hound not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee will not be refunded.

### How to use Entry Forms

1. Complete a separate entry form for each dog.
2. Enter your dog's AKC number (PAL/ILP and Canine Partners numbers) – if you do not have a number, submit the Canine Partners Application on page along with your form to MHWC.
3. Mail the completed form and check made payable to MHWC to the field trial secretary by the closing date (May 19, 2011.)

## GENERAL INFORMATION PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

ALL HANDLERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR ROLL CALL,

INSPECTION AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

Any dog not present 5 minutes after roll call will be considered absent.

**All dogs will be inspected prior to roll call**

### Rules:

1. All dogs entered must be one year of age or older on the day of the test or trial.
2. Dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period.  
Each entry will be examined at inspection. Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused.  
Entry fee for dogs excused, during inspection, for bitches in season or lameness shall be refunded at a date after the test.
3. All dogs running on the 600 yard course will run first followed by dogs running on 300 yard course. Course size is determined by size of dog.
5. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
6. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
7. There will be a \$5 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course in progress, or for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.
8. NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the field chairman, except the appointed field committee.
9. Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
10. **Control of dogs strictly enforced, on leash at all times except when running.**
11. **Clean up and carry out all trash.**
12. **Please pick up all dog feces** and remove with trash or put in receptacle provided at site.

### FIELD AND EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

Terrain is mowed field grass with uneven ground. There is possibility of cactus. Elevation of the course site is about 6800 feet and both days' course layouts in-clude up and downhill slopes. The perimeter of the Zoiboyz ranch is fully fenced.

**MHWC recommends that your hounds be in good physical condition before attempting the course. MHWC will use a battery-powered, continuous loop machine. The lure will consist of white plastic bags**

**A \$20.00 fee will be assessed for any returned checks. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/MHWC/ any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.**

## Canine Partners Enrollment Instructions for Clubs

### Coursing Ability Test

#### **Who should enroll in Canine Partners?**

Dogs who wish to compete in the Coursing Ability Test must be either an AKC-registered dog or a part of the AKC Canine Partners program. Canine Partners is for mixed breeds or dogs who are otherwise ineligible for AKC registration.

Owners who enroll their dogs using the Coursing Ability Enrollment Form will receive the following Canine Partners benefits for their \$19.00 enrollment fee:

#### **How should clubs enroll these dogs in Canine Partners?**

1. Have the dog owners complete the Canine Partners Enrollment Application.
2. Collect payment. (*Payment for Canine Partners enrollment must be separate from event fees.*)
3. Assign the dog a Canine Partner's Enrollment Application Number (E1, E2, etc.) in box located in the upper right hand corner of the application. This number will be used to coordinate the results with the enrollment forms.
4. Have the Judge and Event Secretary complete the Coursing Ability Test Results for each dog indicating the Canine Partner's Enrollment Application Number in the space provided for the registration/listing number.
5. Submit the enrollment forms and separate payment(s) along with the Event Secretary's Report and results.
